Basic Competition information

Divisions: Under black belts will be divided up into Nov. Int. and Adv.
 Some events may have Nov. and Adv. with no Int. Novice (white belt to Green 6th class), Advance (blue belt 5th class to brown belt 1st class)

Chanbara their own shielded head gear and foamed sword!

Sparring: Mouth guards, cup & supporter (males), foam dipped hand, feet and head gear.

Self Defense: Head gear for competitor and attackers.

Weapons: Bo staff must be the height of the competitors. Other weapons must be safe.
